- 7. Font: Times New Roman Font Size: 12

All abstract notifications will be sent to authors/presenters via email. If you do not receive any notification, please email on or before 30/07/2019

Guidelines for Oral Presentation:

Each oral presenter will be allocated **10 minutes** (8+2), including 2 minutes for questions. The date, time and venue of the presentation will be given by email. **Oral presentation PowerPoint slides should be emailed to** scientificasomp2019@mahsa.edu.my at least one week prior to the conference date.

Guidelines for Poster Presentation:

Each poster presenter will be allocated **5 minutes** to present his/her poster, including 2 minutes for questions. Presenters should be at the poster viewing stations 10 minutes before the start of their session and remain there until the session has finished.
