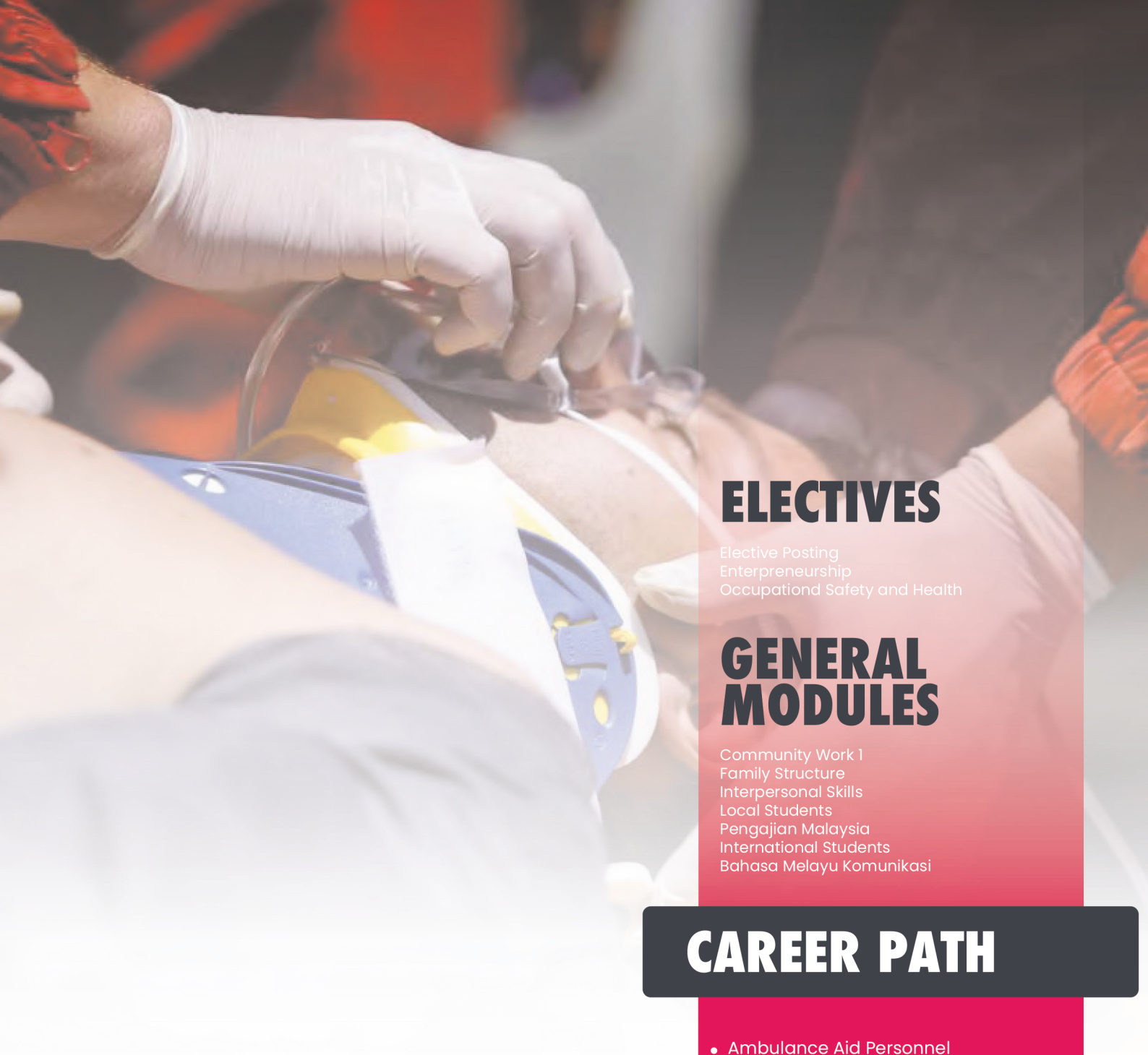

O-Level

Pass with Grade C in English, Mathematics, one Science subject (Biology/Physics/Chemistry/ General Science/Applied Science) and 2 other subjects

Certificate

Certificate (MQF, Level three) related to Health Sciences with minimum CGPA 2.75.

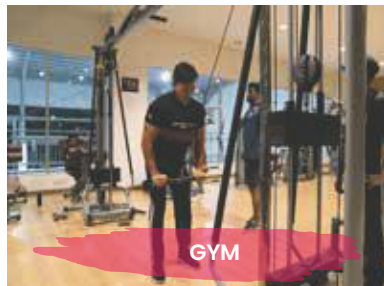

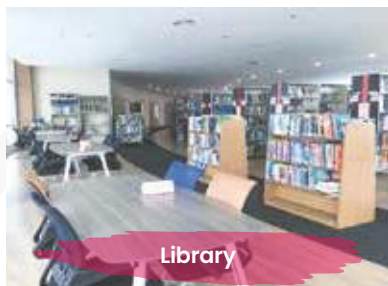
