OVERVIEW

Physiotherapy is a healthcare profession involving in the rehabilitation of patients with neurology, cardio-respiratory and musculoskeletal disorders that emphasises the use of physical approaches in the promotion, restoration and maintenance of health and functional movement of people of all ages.

Upon completion of the Diploma in Physiotherapy programme, graduates possess knowledge and hand-on skills to manage and prevent problems which arise from movement disorders. They will be able to implement techniques to correct or manage various impairments and disabilities of the human body due to diseases, injuries and aging. They should develop the ability to carry out assessment, interpret findings, plan and implement treatment by using physical means. They will be a member of the healthcare team.
