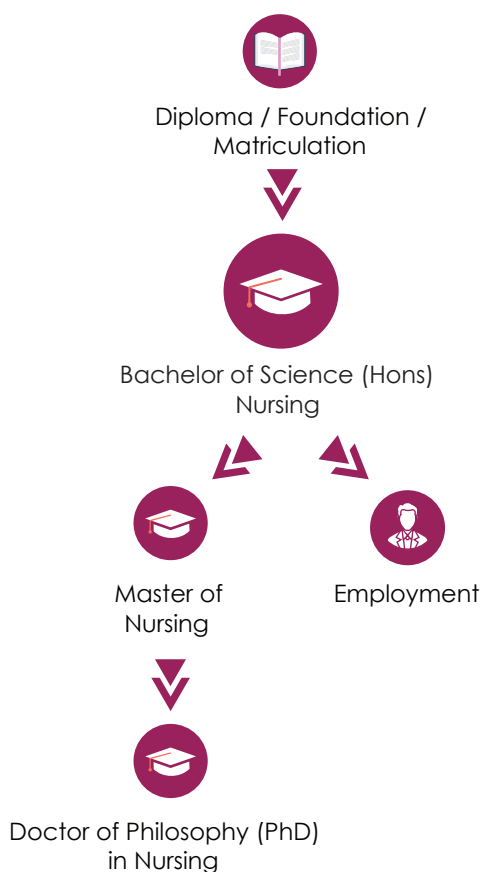

Pass with minimum CGPA 2.50

A-Level

Pass with minimum grade C in 3 subjects

Diploma

Pass any Diploma with minimum CGPA 2.50 (No credit transfer) Equivalent MQF Level 4.

Diploma in Nursing

Pass Diploma in Nursing from a recognized institution by MNB with minimum two (2) years clinical working experience. (Credit transfer allowed)

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

- All students must be certified medically fit by a registered medical practitioner within one month from commencement of the nursing programme
