Hazard Identification & Risk Assessment

Hazard identification is a process to evaluate if any particular situation, item or thing may have the potential to cause harm. This is often used to describe the full process in risk assessment: to identify hazards and risk factors that have the potential to cause harm (hazard identification) (CCOHS, 2018).
